Pre-Conditions for Applications for Selection

To be considered for selection, all athletes within the nominated crew must have fulfilled the following conditions by 30 March 2011. Those athletes who have met the below conditions may submit an expression of interest to Yachting Australia prior to 8 April 2011.

- Be current members of Yachting Australia
- Have demonstrated national and international level performances in the past 12 months in their respective class.

Event Details

The competition will include the following events:

1. Individual fleet racing event:

- 470: men or women or mixed
- Laser standard: men
- Laser radial: women
- Windsurfing: RSX men
- Windsurfing: RSX women

In individual events each country may enter two (2) boats or windsurf by category.

2. Team Racing event:

- 470: one team is made up of two (2) boats
- Laser Radial: one team is made up of three (3) boats
- Windsurf T293: one team is made up of two (2) boards

A country classification will be established by adding the results of the two (2) best individual boats and the one (1) best team (team racing) of each delegation.

In the Team Racing event each country may enter two (2) teams by category.

Note:

In 470 one team is made up of four (4) competitors (two boats) including at least one (1) woman.

In Laser Radial one team is made up of three (3) competitors (three boats) including at least one (1) woman.

In Windsurf T293 one team is made up of two (2) competitors (two boards) including at least one (1) woman.

Each country is authorised to enter a maximum of thirty (30) competitors of whom twelve (12) competitors in the individual event and 18 competitors in the team racing event and one (1) substitute per delegation.

For the Individual and Team Racing Championship, boats and windsurfs (including sails) will be provided by the OC and allocated by draw. Competitors will bring their personal buoyancy. Motor boats will be reserved for coaches.

The Individual event will last seven (7) days and the Team racing event will last 4 days.

The regattas will be organised in accordance with the most recent "Racing Rules of Sailing" of the International Sailing Federation (ISAF), and in accordance with the Class Rules concerned unless otherwise stated in the "Sailing Instructions". In any dispute, the English text will be regarded as authoritative.

The program and the duration of the competitions are fixed by the Executive Committee and the CTI.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Australian University Sport (AUS) currently applies the following regulations when selecting representative teams to participate in FISU competitions:

a) FISU Regulations 5.2.1

Only the following may participate as competitors in a FISU Sporting Event:

i) Students who are currently enrolled and proceeding towards a diploma or higher at a university or similar institute whose status is recognised by the appropriate national academic authority of their country (e.g. the Australian Government Department of Education).

ii) Former students of the institutions mentioned in (i) who have completed their academic degree/diploma in the 12 months preceding the event. (Must provide copy of Graduation Certificate)

b) FISU Regulations 5.2.3

All competitors must satisfy the following conditions.

i) be a national of the country they represent (therefore hold a full 10 year Australian passport)
ii) be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age on January 1st in the year of the event

c) Students studying abroad are eligible for selection provided they satisfy FISU regulations 5.2.1 and 5.2.3, including the institution being recognised by that Governments academic authority.
