



RYA-YA Yachtmaster Coastal and Offshore Examination Checklist

The following documents **MUST** be supplied to your Examiner before or on the day of your exam:

1. Completed application form – download from www.yachting.org.au
2. Logbook with qualifying passages signed off
3. A copy of your First Aid certificate – valid for 3 years from date of issue
4. A copy of your Radio Operator's certificate
5. A recent passport photograph
6. Identification
7. Fee of \$465 (Yachtmaster Offshore) \$405 (Yachtmaster Coastal)

If you are applying for **MCA/STCW Commercial endorsement(s)**, please also include the following:

1. All the above items
2. Medical form AMSA 303, MCA ENG1 (copy) or MCA ML5 (original)
3. Copy of your Sea Survival course certificate – valid for 5 years from date of issue or STCW certs
4. Copy of Professional Practices and Responsibilities (PPR) certificate
5. Fee of \$75

- Failure to present the relevant documentation may result in cancellation of examination
- Note that all certificates must be current
